## Roles & Responsibilities:

To ensure compliance with the provisions of UGC regulations 2009 as well as the provision of any law for the time being in force concerning ragging, at the institutional level.

Designing strategies and action plan for curbing the Menace of Ragging in the college by adopting array of activities.

To publicize and facilitate anti-ragging measures through signage boards / awareness programmes etc.

The Committee is required to over see the discipline in the college particularly to safe guard the newly admitted first year students. The following are the guidelines for the committee to maintain discipline and prevent ragging.

1. Students are expected to possess the sense of belongings and have respect for the property of the institute and individuals. Any student found intentionally damaging institutional assets like fixtures, equipment, instruments, furnitures, books, buildings, vehicles etc and / or individual properties liable for severe punishment including expulsion.
2. Smoking and chewing pan or ghutkha in the campus are not permitted. Use of alcoholic drinks within the premises of the institute is strictly prohibited. The students must abstain from the use of drugs or any other narcotics.
3. Every student must abide the rules and regulations framed by the institute from time to time. Every student will be issued personal identity card for one academic year and he/she should carry the same at all times.
4. Every student must be punctual and regular in attending all classes and sessional tests. Students are expected to join NSS and NCC and participate in games, sports & co-curricular activities.
5. If any student is found indulging in ragging, the committee has to take it seriously and award punishment to the students of the due enquiry.
6. All antiragging cases should be reported immediately to the police along with charge sheet and immediately the students indulging in ragging shall be suspended until the completion of enquiry. If found guilty, they may be expelled from the college after giving transfer certificate.
7. The punishments should be given to the students indulging the ragging as per the antiragging rules of UGC regulations 2009 which are posulated herewith:

| Action   | Punishment   |
|--|--|
| Testing, embrassing or forces or criminally intimidating a student                   | Imprisonment up to extent of 6 months or fine up to max of Rs 1000/- or both |
| Assaulting or using criminal forces or criminally intimidating the student           | Imprisonment up to 1 year or fine up to Rs2000/- or both.                    |
| Wrongfully restraining or confining or causing hurt to a student                     | Imprisonment up to a term of 2 years or fine up to Rs 5000/- or both.        |
| Causing hurt to or kidnapping or raping or committing unnatural offence to a student | Imprisonment up to a term of 2 years or fine up to Rs 10,000/- or both.      |
| Causing death or abetting suicide  | Imprisonment for a term of 10 years and fine extending up to Rs 50,000/-.    |

**The above orders will come in to force with immediate effect.**

## Measures to prevent ragging in the Institution level

### 1. Before admissions :

- 1.1 The advertisement shall clearly mentioned that ragging is totally banned/prohibited in the institution. If any one found guilty of ragging, he/she is liable to be punished appropriately.
- 1.2 The brochure and instruction booklet for candidates had been in block letters these regulations in full.
- 1.3. The application form of admission shall have a printed undertaking, preferably both in English/ Telugu/Hindi and in one of the regional languages known to the candidate.

### 2. On Admission :

- 2.1 Every candidate admitted to the institution shall be provided an information booklet and an counselor had been appointed to whom they have to seek the help.
- 2.2 An “**Joint Sensitization**” programme had been conducted associated with seniors and freshers to have a academic environment of the institution.
- 2.3 Freshers shall be encouraged to report incidents of ragging either as victims or as witnesses to the anti ragging committee or principal
